Nello specifico:

**Vocabulary**: describing appearance, words often confused: personality adjectives, clothes and fashion, compound nouns: travel, travel, idioms: happiness and sadness, noun suffixes: -ness, -ity, the environment, prefixes: semi-, under-, over-, re-, co-, inter-, collocations: charities, influence, crime, noun prefixes: mis-, dis-, apologizing and apologies, synonyms: the law, law and order, advertising, collocations: advertising, money

and describing amounts, trade, perception and observation, adverb-adjective collocations, sight and sounds, wildfire and the habitat, paying it forward, words with more than one meaning.

Su *Insight Intermediate 2nd ed.*: present simple and present continuous, verb patterns (+ing/infinitive with/without to with difference in meaning), narrative tenses (past simple, past continuous, past perfect), verbs + prepositions: travel, used to and would, past simple and present perfect, adverbs (sentence adverbs, adverbs of manner and degree), present perfect simple and present perfect continuous, expressing the future (present simple, present continuous, will, going to, may/might), verbs+prepositions, future continuous and future perfect, first and second conditionals, three-part phrasal verbs with to and with, modals of obligation, prohibition and permission, the passive, have/get something done, reported speech, reported questions and commands, third conditional, I wish and if only, defining and non-defining relative clauses.

**Communicative functions and speaking:** talking about discrimination, speculating, describing positions, identifying facts, opinions and speculations, asking for and giving opinions, expressing agreement, partial agreement and disagreement, describing amounts.

Writing: an informal email, a story, an opinion essay.
